

Heights National Alumni Association Scholarships

(Three (3) annual scholarships given by the Alumni of Castle Heights Military Academy)

Description and 2026 Application Form

Application Deadline Date: February 15, 2026 (postmarked)

Heights National Alumni Association (alumni of Castle Heights Military Academy) will grant **three (3)** scholarships in the amount of **\$2,000** each for the **2026-2027 academic year**.

These scholarships are available to those with some connection to Castle Heights Military Academy (including alumni, faculty, staff, descendants of alumni, faculty, and staff, spouses of alumni, faculty, staff, stepchildren of alumni, faculty, staff, etc.). These scholarships will be for use at any accredited university, college, junior college, technical institute, graduate school, or professional program. The scholarships will be based upon merit, not upon financial need.

Only one member from the same family (i.e., brothers and/or sisters, etc.) will be eligible to be considered for a scholarship in any given year. If two applications are received in the same year from the same family, the family will be notified that only one of the applicants from the family may apply and the family will be asked to choose the family member they want the Scholarship Selection Committee to consider.

In addition to establishing their relationship to Castle Heights Military Academy, applicants for the Heights National Alumni Association scholarship must have a cumulative **3.0 GPA** (HS or College) and provide an **official transcript** (to be sent to the Scholarship Committee by the applicant's registrar). **Transcript should include end of semester grades for Fall 2025.** Applicants should also demonstrate some involvement and/or leadership in extracurricular activities, honor societies, civic organizations/community, and/or athletics. ****Note: Applicants who have been given appointments to attend one of the U.S. military service academies will not be eligible to receive one of the CHMA scholarships. The Academies are: U.S. Military Academy, U.S. Naval Academy, U.S. Air Force Academy, U.S. Merchant Marine Academy, and the U.S. Coast Guard Academy. United States service academies are federally funded and do not charge tuition: therefore, CHMA scholarships will not be awarded to students who attend any service academy.**

Applicants should include a stamped, self-addressed envelope with the completed application. Once applicants' files are complete, an acknowledgement will be sent confirming receipt of all application materials. **The Scholarship Selection Committee will have a decision on the recipients of the scholarships by April 15, 2026.** Scholarship winners will receive a letter of congratulations from the Chair of the Scholarship Selection Committee, and their names will be announced in the June 2026 Heights National Alumni Association Newsletter.

Applications will be evaluated by the Scholarship Selection Committee, which consists of four members of the Board of Directors. The Heights National Alumni Association will issue checks directly to the collegiate institutions to be attended by the scholarship winners. **Scholarship money may only be used for tuition, fees, books, and room/board.** Applicants who do not receive scholarships are encouraged to reapply the following year.
